Membership Agreement/Medical Waiver: It is understood that pool memberships are non-transferable and the dues paid for such memberships are non-refundable. Waterford residents must be in good standing with the Waterford HOA with regard to annual dues and assessment fees in order to purchase a pool membership. The member and all guests of the member shall save and hold harmless Waterford Swim and Racquet Club, Waterford HOA II, Waterford HOA II Board of Directors, Professional Pool Management lifeguards and Adkins Property Management from and against all liability, claims, and demand on account of personal injuries (including, but not limited to, foregoing workman's compensation and death claims) or property loss or damage of any kind whatsoever, which may arise out of or be in any manner connected with the performance of this contract, regardless of whether such injury, loss, or damage shall be caused by, or claimed to be caused by, the negligence of the members of any of the above named or by any of their agents or representatives.

**By Laws:** The undersigned agrees to conform to and be bound by the Rules and Regulations of the Waterford Swim and Racquet Club, as they may be amended from time to time. By signing below, you acknowledge you have read and understand the rules of the Waterford Swim and Racquet Club. Violation of these rules or allowing the use of passes by people other than those listed above may result in suspension of privileges without reimbursement of paid dues.

# Waterford Pool Rules and Regulations

- 1. The pool will be open for use during the times listed on the schedule. No one will be allowed in the pool at other hours with the exception of supervised swim practice. Entering the pool during unscheduled times will be considered trespassing. Hours may vary due to weather and season, special activities, or maintenance.
- 2. Members and guests must register at the gate before entering the pool and must present membership cards to the lifeguard on duty. Members may not enter without a valid Waterford pool pass.
- 3. Members may purchase guest passes at the gate for \$5.00 per day. All guests must be accompanied by a member and sign-in with the life guard on duty upon arrival. Members are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Members may purchase guest passes in advance from the Waterford Property Manager.
- 4. Members may purchase a "nanny" pass for a babysitter, which may only be used when accompanied by the child/children. Limit of 1 passes per membership at \$50.00.
- 5. Any minor under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a chaperone 16 or older. This rule will be rigidly enforced. If any doubt occurs as to the child's ability to swim, the lifeguard on duty may ask the child to leave and to be accompanied by a parent or guardian on future visits.
- 6. The wading pool is for the benefit of children five years or younger, who must be accompanied by an adult.
- 7. The entire pool deck must be cleared of people for 30 minutes after each strike of Thunder or Lightening. You may not reenter the pool deck to collect belongings during those 30 minutes. The decision to close the pool due to weather is at the discretion of the pool management company.

### CODE OF CONDUCT

- 8. Only one person may be on the diving board at a time. The area in front of the diving board is for diving only. Swimming in front or under the board is not permitted. Diving or jumping from the side of the board is not permitted. Divers must swim to the ladder closest to the Lifeguard to exit the pool. Diving area must be clear before the next diver jumps off the board. Diving in the shallow end of the pool is not permitted.
- 9. Dunking, wrestling, running, towel flipping, bullying and rough play deemed unsafe by the lifeguards is not permitted and may result in disciplinary action. Yelling for Help when not necessary will not to tolerated.
- 10. Intoxicated or belligerent behavior will not be tolerated and may result in suspension of pool privileges without refund. Foul Language will not be tolerated.
- 11. No smoking or tobacco in or around the pool area or on Waterford Swim and Racquet Club grounds. This includes cigarettes, tobacco, e-cigs.
- 12. Hard balls, any ball other than squishy balls, towels, paper cups, popsicle sticks, plastic straws, etc. are not permitted in the pool as they may endanger other swimmers or cause damage to the filtration system.

## Waterford Pool Rules and Regulations Continued

- 13. Air filled flotation devices are not permitted. Noodles and foam filled life jackets are acceptable. No flotation device may be worn when jumping off the diving board.
- 14. Willful defacing or destruction of property will not be tolerated and will result in immediate termination of pool privileges without refund. Members will be liable for losses or damages by their guests and their children.
- 15. Glass bottles or containers are prohibited within the fenced pool area.
- 16. Drinks or food items are not permitted in the pool or on the pool apron.
- 17. `Pool furniture may not be moved outside of the pool area or placed in the pool.
- 18. Pets are prohibited from entering the pool area.
- 19. Waterford Swim and Racquet Club is not responsible for lost or misplaced items. All personal possessions will be removed from the pool and dressing rooms at the end of each day. Lost items are not the responsibility of lifeguards.
- 20. Lifeguard instruction must be followed AT ALL TIMES, they are here for YOUR safety.
- 21. Members are fully responsible for the conduct of their children.
- 22. Proper swimming attire is required. Cutoffs, thongs and non-bathing attire are not permitted in the pool or on the pool deck.
- 23. Playing of loud music is prohibited.
- 24. Lap Lanes are for the use of Lap Swimmers. Swimming are permitted in lap lanes while there are no lap swimmers but lap lane must be cleared when a lap swimmer arrives. Lap swimmers should notify lifeguards to clear lap laps when they arrive.
- 25. Property Managers should be notified 1 week in advance of any parties at the pool via completion of a POOL PARTY FORM to ensure proper lifeguard coverage is available. Without prior notification, a lastminute life guard must be called and your party may not begin until the life guard has arrived and you will be subject to pay for the additional lifeguard. The pool may be rented prior to pool opening or after pool closing for an additional fee.

Failure to cooperate may result in up to and including verbal warning, ejection from the pool, suspension of pool privileges, revoking pool membership with no refunds. The property manager, pool manager or Home Owners Association Board are authorized to close the pool should, in their judgement, circumstances warrant and further, may add to this list other rules that pertain to a particular situation.
