Have you paid your dues?

Waterford HOA dues statements were mailed to all households in early January, and thanks to all who have already paid. Late fees (\$25) will be added on April 1, July 1, October 1 or January 1 (2018) if not paid by then. Dues are separate from pool membership and pay for upkeep and improvements to the common property of our neighborhood including the ponds, clubhouse and tennis courts. Our Ponds

Do you enjoy the beautiful Waterford Ponds? We do, too! Rules for use and safety are posted near each pond. Ponds are for residents only. Recently there has been a significant increase in activity at the ponds. Of course we want everyone to enjoy our beautiful amenities, but we must be diligent to protect and be good stewards of our resources. If you bring anything to the ponds with you, please, take it away. If you have trash, throw it away. Never leave fishing line on the ground! Plastic is dangerous to wildlife and to the pond filters, as well. Please, monitor your children. Also, remind your children to never throw the pond rocks into the water. If you see suspicious or illegal activity do not hesitate to call the police!

How to be a Good Neighbor

<u>Pets</u>

Waterford HOA follows the Fayette County ordinances regarding pets which states:

"All dogs in Fayette County must be on a leash, behind a fence or on the dog owner's property under the owner's supervision at all times when outside. Dogs cannot run-atlarge, even under voice command, and they must wear their current license and rabies tags at all times."

Please, be respectful to your neighbors and leash your dogs.

It is preferred, if you choose to use an invisible fence, that it is used in the back yard. If you are on a corner lot or choose to use an invisible fence in the front yard, it should stop your pet at least four feet from the sidewalk.

Cleaning up after your pet is the law. All pet waste on public or unowned-private land must be sanitarily and properly disposed of in an appropriate trash receptacle. The "Pooper Scooper" ordinance is enforced by the Lexington Police Department at (859) 258-3600. <u>Blocking</u> the Sidewalk

Fayette County ordinance states:

"Parking on Sidewalks or in Yards: It is unlawful to park any vehicle on

It is also unlawful to park in the front or side yard of a corner lot except on an approved residential driveway [Section 18-129]" Please, do not park your vehicle over the sidewalk. This forces your neighbors to walk in the street to get around your vehicle, creating a safety issue.

Please do not feed the ducks.

The care and maintenance of the neighborhood ponds require a big part of the HOA budget each year. The HOA has spent lots of money trying to keep fish in the ponds and the grounds surrounding the ponds clean. Feeding the ducks and geese creates waste that is unhealthy for the fish and messy and unattractive for people that visit the ponds. While it is understandable that people like to feed the ducks and geese, we ask that they do not do so at the Waterford ponds. Please understand that it is not in the best interest of the neighborhood to continue this practice.
