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All Waterford neighbors are familiar with the issue of speeding and failing to stop at stop signs on Clearwater Way. Several neighbors have begun the process of obtaining a petition to request the Lexington Division of Traffic Engineering to perform a traffic study at Bridgemont Lane and Clearwater Way. We are in hopes that after the study, the city will place a 4-way stop at the intersection. It is a rather lengthy process.

"Once a successful petition is produced, the Division of Traffic Engineering will schedule the data collection necessary to evaluate the intersection. The data will then be processed and evaluated against warrant criteria. Warrant criteria utilized for justification of a Multiway Stop installation by the Division of Traffic Engineering is based on the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices-2009 edition."

Even with the petition and even after the traffic study, it does not guarantee the stop signs will be added; however, it does give us the opportunity to open a dialogue with the city regarding the traffic issues in our neighborhood.

Some specific concerns include:

- Increased traffic in the area making it difficult to turn off of Bridgemont onto Clearwater safely.
- Bus stop at the intersection. Safety of the children at the bus stop.
- Speeding between Man O War and Ridgewater in both directions.

If you live on Bridgemont Lane, Brookwater Court, Brookwater Lane, Clearwater Way, Ridgewater Drive, Whitewater Drive, or Woodstream Court, please, contact Lynn Watts at <u>lynnleenicole@gmail.com</u> to sign the petition for the traffic study. Other Waterford residents interested in signing the petition may do so, as well.
