# Pool Rules and Regulations Entry Provisions

- 1. The pool will be open for use during the days and times listed on the schedule posted at http://www.waterfordlexington.com except in cases of inclement weather, special activities or maintenance. Entering the pool during unscheduled times without prior approval will be considered trespassing.
- 2. Pool members must present a valid Waterford pool card I.D. to the lifeguard on duty at the gate on each occasion of entering the pool. Member admittance will not be permitted without a valid pool card I.D.
- 3. Guest pass cards are issued one time only, and should be treated like cash- they and will not be replaced if lost. Homeowners who pay annual HOA dues in full prior to April 1st, 2021 will receive a total of three guest pass cards (15 guests), rather than two guest pass cards (10 guests). Guests must be accompanied by a pool member and sign in with the lifeguard on duty upon arrival. A maximum of five guests per visit to the pool is allowed by members, unless preapproved by Management. Members are responsible for the behavior of their guests.
- 4. Pool members may purchase additional guest passes at the gate. Guest pass prices are \$5.00 per day, per guest, except for Memorial and Labor Days (\$10.00 per day), and the Fourth of July (\$20.00 per day). Guest pass cards issued for each household per season may be used any days except for Opening Weekend, Memorial Day, Labor Day and the Fourth of July.
- 5. Nanny/babysitter pool card I.D.s may only be used to access the pool when accompanied by the child/children listed on the membership agreement. Added grandchildren that do not reside with the primary applicant must be accompanied by an adult member listed from their agreement.
- 6. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a chaperone 16 or older. This rule will be strictly enforced. If any doubt occurs as to the child's ability to swim, the lifeguard on duty may require the child to leave and to be accompanied by a parent or guardian on future visits.
- 7. The wading pool (baby pool) is for the use of children five years or younger, who must be accompanied by an adult.
- 8. Lightning is deemed to have occurred nearby when lightning is seen or thunder is heard by a lifeguard. If uncertain as to whether lightning has occurred, lifeguards will verify using an app such as Weatherbug. Lifeguards will clear the entire pool deck of people for 30 minutes after each occurrence of thunder or lightning. Unsupportiveness and/or failure to promptly comply may be grounds for suspension or termination of pool privileges. For safety reasons, no one may reenter the pool deck to collect belongings during those 30 minutes. Management is authorized to close the pool due to inclement weather conditions.

#### **Code of Conduct**

- 1. Only one person may be on the diving board at a time. The area in front of the diving board is for diving only. Swimming in front of or underneath the diving board, or diving or jumping from the side of the board is not permitted. Divers must swim to the nearest ladder to the right of the diving board (not under the lap lane marker or toward the diving board side wall) to exit the pool. The diving area must be clear before the next diver jumps off the board. Diving into the shallow end of the pool is not permitted.
- 2. Swim goggles or face masks may not be worn when diving or jumping from the diving board.
- 3. Dunking, wrestling, running, towel flipping, bullying, rough play and any other activities deemed unsafe by the lifeguards are not permitted and may result in disciplinary action. Calling out for help when not necessary will not be tolerated.
- 4. Intoxication, belligerent behavior, and any language considered profane, abusive, vulgar, harassing, demeaning or otherwise inappropriate, whether directed toward other patrons or lifeguards, will not be tolerated and may result in immediate suspension or termination of pool privileges without refund.
- 5. No smoking or tobacco is permitted in or around the pool area or on Waterford Swim and Racquet Club grounds. This includes cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, and e-cigs.
- 6. Towels, paper cups, popsicle sticks, plastic straws, balls other than squishy balls, etc. are not permitted in the pool as they may endanger other swimmers or damage the filtration system.
- 7. Air-filled flotation devices are not permitted. Noodles and foam-filled life jackets are acceptable. No flotation device may be worn when diving or jumping off the diving board.
- 8. Willful defacement or destruction of property will result in immediate termination of pool privileges without refund (nanny pass, guest fees, etc.). Pool members are liable for losses or damages caused by their guests and/or children.
- 9. Pool members and guests are responsible for cleaning up after themselves by removing all containers, wrappers, spilled food/drink, and other trash from deck tables and the surrounding area that they occupied prior to departure.

- 10. Glass bottles or containers are strictly prohibited within the fenced-in pool area.
- 11. Drinks or food items are not permitted in the pool or on the pool apron.
- 12. Pool furniture may not be moved outside of the pool area or placed in the pool.
- 13. Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
- 14. Waterford Swim and Racquet Club is not responsible for lost or misplaced items. All personal possessions will be removed from the pool and dressing rooms at the end of each day. Lost items are not the responsibility of lifeguards or management.
- 15. Lifeguards are present for YOUR safety. Their instructions must be followed promptly and AT ALL TIMES. Noncompliance, argumentativeness, and other language or actions that disregard or diminish lifeguard authority are grounds for disciplinary action.
- 16. Pool members are fully responsible for the conduct of their children and guests.
- 17. Proper swimming attire (no cutoffs, thongs and non-bathing attire) is required in the pool area.
- 18. The playing of loud music is prohibited.
- 19. Casual swimming is permitted in lap lanes except when used by lap swimmers. On arrival, lap swimmers should notify lifeguards to clear the lap lanes.
- 20. These rules and regulations shall be in effect at all times and for all events unless superseded by Board policy or by a Board-approved, event-specific waiver.

Noncompliance may result in disciplinary actions including verbal warning, ejection from the pool, suspension of pool privileges, and termination of pool privileges without refund (nanny pass, guest fees, etc.). The Property Manager, Pool Manager, and the Association Board of Directors are authorized to close the pool should, in their judgement, circumstances warrant and may modify these rules in response to future developments.

#### Waterford COVID-19 Acknowledgement of Risks

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person to person contact. As a result, federal, state and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

The Waterford Homeowners Association II "Waterford HOA",
and Professional Pool Management "PPM" have put in place preventative measures to
help reduce the spread of COVID-19; however neither Waterford HOA nor PPM can
guarantee that anyone working for or attending, a gathering located on Waterford HOA property
or managed by PPM will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending any
program or activity on Waterford HOA property or as part of any PPM managed activity
may increase the risk of contracting COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk of exposure that myself, children, anyone residing in my Waterford home and anyone I may be exposed to, in relation to participating in activities held on Waterford HOA property and administered by PPM, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed or infected by COVID-19 may result from the action, omission or negligence of myself and others, including but not limited to Waterford HOA, board of directors, employees or volunteers, and PPM owners, officials, employees, volunteers, rentals, programs or pool activities participants and their families.

I voluntarily assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to myself or anyone residing in my household that relates to participation of managed programs on HOA property in relation to PPM managed programs, including but not limited to personal injury, disability, death, illness, damage, loss, claim, liability or expense of any kind, that I or my family may experience in relation to managed programs located on Waterford HOA property. I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge and hold harmless Waterford HOA,

and PPM, their board of directors, their employees, agents and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liability claims actions, damages, costs or expense of any kind rising out or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of Waterford HOA, and PPM their employees, agents and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during or after participation in any PPM program held on Waterford HOA property.
